## WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

If you hear a warning of an emergency incident in the Parish, go indoors, close the windows and doors, tune into your local radio and TV stations for advice.

Cooperate with Emergency Services fully, stay calm & listen to instructions which may mean evacuating your home. If you need to evacuate take warm clothing in winter and any medication that you are on.

In the event of a major utilities failure, (e.g. Gas, Electricity and Water) you may be required to isolate your supplies, so get to know where your stop cocks, gas valves and electricity main cut switches are located.

Keep an emergency kit in your home e.g. tinned food, bottles of drinking water, torch & supply of batteries. COMMUNICATION

An Incident Control Centre will be set up at Chelwood Gate Village Hall (with back-up in the Danehill Memorial Hall) where the Parish Representative (or Deputy) will be located to give advice.

If you are a witness to an incident and can be of direct assistance then contact the relevant authority on the telephone numbers given above.

## ASSEMBLY POINTS

Both Chelwood Gate Village Hall and the Danehill Memorial Hall are designated assembly points and, should there be a need, these will be utilised for temporary respite and food.

Danehill Parish Council hold a volunteer listing of all those who are willing to assist in an emergency i.e 4 wheel drive vehicles, tractors, chain saws, bedding, food etc., this helps us assure our Parishioners of a timely, practical response should the need arise.
